

Treasure hunt in Split

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Students will:

- research local attractions and create short video where they act as first as virtual tour guides and then on-site tour guides and share information with visitors;
- take pictures of a chosen spot and add a voice recording with key points about the spot
- they will be tourist guides of their own hometown – they will show the town to their peers both in English and Croatian, depending on the age of students.
- After the sightseeing, they will have a treasure hunt in mixed groups to check how much they have learned.

A prize and a certificate will be awarded to the winning team.

Main objectives:

One of the aims is to promote geography among students and its importance in everyday life. It also encourages students to implement the knowledge gained through English and Geography classes in specific situations improving their lifelong learning skills.

Treasure hunt is a collaborative team building activity where students are faced with problem-solving challenges. The objective is to complete the tasks as a team. Each task guides the teams to the next and ultimately the hidden treasure. Team members must quickly figure out that the best way to complete the adventure before others is by working together as one. Not only they learn the concept of teamwork and cooperation, but they also have a lot of fun.

Event language: Croatian and English

The event will be: “Live” in presence

Reference organization: Osnovna škola Bol, Split

Expected duration: about 5 hours in total

Event program:

Pre-activity:

- 120 minutes for gathering interesting information (in groups) and making a draft for the on-site tour
- 60 minutes for creating a short video

Main activity:

- cca. 60 minutes for guided tour
- cca. 90 minutes for treasure hunt (depending on the number of tasks given)
- cca. 30 minutes task analysis and evaluation

Each **group** has a task is to find as many objects as possible and to take pictures of them.

The group that finds most of the objects, takes a group photo with it and has the most points, will be considered the **winner**.

Group representative sends the **group photos** to the teacher's mobile phone number.

Each photo must be numbered according to the number of the question to be accepted as valid!

- 1) The French came here in Napoleon time. They modernized our postal system and introduced mailboxes to Dalmatia. Your task is to find and take a picture with the only remaining mailbox.
- 2) These plants look like flowers, and they are flowers indeed. The funny thing is that we eat their buds. They grow mostly on walls and are typical for Dalmatia. Find it and take a group photo.
- 3) He was the father of Croatian literature and was the first to use Croatian in serious literature. When he wrote in Latin, his big admirer was Henry VIII. Find his statue and take a group photo.
- 4) He was killed by emperor Diocletian for being a Christian back in 304 at Salona. Ironically, he is now buried in the emperor's tomb. Find his statue and take a group picture of it. If you manage to find an old statue you will get **double points**. *
- 5) It used to be the main entrance to the palace from the sea. Take a group photo there.
- 6) If you had any kind of disease, you would have to spend 40 days in it. Take a group photo with it.
- 7) Guys don't come to this place because they don't like the smell of the chemical element that smells like rotten eggs. At that place there is another smelly thing being sold. Take a group photo there.
- 8) In 1942 Italian fascists demolished the synagogue and its books were burned down at the place of this bronze plate. Take a group photo there.
- 9) Split was inscribed on this list exactly 40 years ago. To be more precise, on October 26th 1979. Find this bronze plate and take a group picture.
- 10) It is the narrowest street in the palace. Take a group photo there.
- 11) Rub his finger and your wish will come true. Take a group photo making a wish.
- 12) He was the father of psychoanalysis. He lived in this house in 1898. Take a group photo with him.

Joker* - if you find a big Black Horse in its natural size with a lamp on his head you can replace any of the items you could not find with it. Don't forget to take the picture.

1 point is awarded for every correct answer apart from questions marked with asterix (*).
